



job. With mounting inflation, this catastrophe is also distressing their mental health.

Of the 25,000 students who graduated from different universi-

ties in Balochistan in 2021, only 2,000 were able to secure a job. According to the Pakistan Labor Force Study 2021, Balochistan has the highest redundancy rate in the country. Despite its latent Balochistan status, has always lagged behind other provinces across most development-related metrics. In recent times.


