It is binding on government and opposition to complete consultation process in regard to caretaker PM within three days and send the name.

(APP): Balochistan government has inked an agreement with SZABIST-ZABTech (iTVE) (Institute of Technical and Vocational Education) to initiate a vocational training programme to impart technical skills to 2700 youth in more than 18 trades in a period of three years in order to produce the quality technical human resource. The Chief Secretary Balochistan Abdul Aziz Uqaili has witnessed the agreement with SZABIST-ZABTech (iTVE) to initiate the program on a public-private partnership mode to impart technical skills among youth to get good employment opportunities under CPEC projects and also tap jobs in global labor markets.

Court again summons PTI chief for recording statement in Toshakhana case

ISLAMABAD (APP):A lower court on Monday rejected a request to postpone recording of the statement of PTI chairman under Section-342 in the Toshakhana criminal case and summoned him again on Tuesday.

Additional District and Sessions Judge Hamayun Dilawar, hearing the case, observed that the PTI chief and his lawyer had disappointed the court as the purpose of such applications was to delay the trial. It was the third consecutive date fixed by the court to record the statement of the accused, who, however, requested to postpone it.

The former prime minister, who appeared before the court along with his lawyer Khawaja Haris, prayed for more time for recording his statement.

The judge remarked that as per the defence lawyer the statement could not be prepared due to the Ashura holidays. The PTI chairman had already been given sufficient time in that

The defence lawyer's stance that the court was running the trial in a fast way, was also not fair, he

Khawaja Haris argued that it was an impression that the sessions court wanted to conclude the trial early so that their appeals in high court would become ineffective. The court itself had appointed him as a representative of PTI chief and testified the witnesses, while the accused should have right to appoint his representative himself, he added.

The lawyer said they had challenged the trial

court's decisions before the high court and his client required some time before recording his statement under Section-342.

The counsel for the Election Commission of Pakistan (ECP), Amjad Pervaiz, said five appeals were pending with the high court, which only aimed at getting a stay order against the trial. The accused had requested a stay order to the top court but his case was dismissed, he said, adding the trial court could continue the proceedings.

The lawyer said that for the first time an objection had been raised against the sessions court after the indictment. They should approach the high court and prove that the indictment was wrong, he added.

The court adjourned the case till Tuesday.



Once again, dozens of innocents have paid in blood for their state's failure to apprehend an attack on the country and its people. At the time geopolitical tensions and global economic volatility these lines were being written, at least 35 civilian lives unstable situation. UN's new agenda for peace

The world is at an inflection point with mounting contributing to a fraught and

growing challenges in an increasingly fragmented international system. The resurgence of East-West tensions. Ukraine war and intensifying US-China confrontation have further shrunk the space for multilateral cooperation. Multilateralism though has been in retreat for well over a decade now.

Strong headwinds unleashed by competing crises are making the future outlook a troubled one.

Climate change has emerged as among the present era's greatest risks. Yet a deeply divided world is increasingly falling short key issues which will be concerns of countries, and lence", so as to promote in 26 countries around the Dawn

It is clearly time for the international community to take stock and consider how to forge agreement on a global framework to address common challenges. A major initiative to do that is planned at the UN Summit of the Future called by Secretary General (SG) António Guterres and endorsed by all member states of the world body. This summit, sched-

uled for September 2024,

will seek to evolve a consensus on what a shared future should be and identify the means to achieve it. Guterres has described the summit as a "once in a generation opportunity" to strengthen multilateralism, renew the commitment to core principles and adopt an action-oriented 'Pact for the Future', which will set out concrete responses to global challenges. This is expected to emerge from in- among people across the tergovernmental negotiations ahead of the summit.

As part of the preparatory process for these deliberations, Guterres has issued nine policy briefs on

states. A New Agenda for Peace, the policy paper unveiled earlier this month, focuses on issues of peace and security. This offers twelve specific proposals in five priority areas. In his introduction to the report and op-eds he recently authored, the SG states that with the post-Cold War period over, the world is moving towards a new global order with multipolarity as a defining feature. Never before have countries had to confront so many cross-boundary sources of instability and insecurity. Peace remains elusive as conflicts continue across world

According Guterres, all of this makes international cooperation an imperative in order to avoid more human suffering. This is especially so when disquiet is growing world that governments and international organisations are failing to deliver for them. He calls for a "new multilateralism" which goes beyond the narrow security

The second priority area identified is a "paradigm for prevention" within countries to deal with "all forms of viosocial cohesion, create links between sustainable development, climate action and peace ensure meaningful participation of women and fully respect all dimensions of human rights. This is an ambitious goal given the uneven record among developing

countries on this account. The third area in the report concerns UN peacekeeping. It proposes updating peacekeeping operations to adjust to changing conflict environments, especially challenges posed by unresolved conflicts where there is no peace to

The actions proposed include avoiding unrealistic mandates for peacekeeping missions, having more integrated operations and recommitting to reform in this area—all welcome and implementable suggestions. They are directly relevant for Pakistan, which has been among the world's top troop contributing countries to UN peacekeeping missions for over six decades. Since 1960, over 200,000 Pakistani service men and women have served in 46 UN missions

world. Currently, over 4,300 service personnel are deployed in 10 missions.

The fourth priority focuses on prevention of the weaponisation of emerging domains and technologies and promoting "responsible innovation". This calls for measures to address threats posed by new technologies, including artificial intelligence, and urges a prohibition on lethal autonomous weapons systems. There can be no disagreement with the contention that "machines with the power and discretion to take lives without human involvement are morally repugnant and politically unacceptable and should be prohibited by international law'

The last priority action area recommends building a stronger collective security machinery, including reform of the Security Council, General Assembly and the UN's disarmament agency. The document calls for expediting negotiations for Council reform to make it more "iust and representative" and democratise its working methods. -- Courtesy

Russian ballistic missile strikes kill at least 6 people in Zelenskyy's hometown in central Ukraine

KYIV: Russian ballistic missiles slammed into an apartment complex and a university building in President Volodymyr Zelenskyy's hometown Monday, killing six people and wounding 75 others as the blasts trapped residents beneath rubble, Ukrainian officials said. One of the two missiles that hit the central city of Kryvyi Rihon destroyed part of an apartment building between the fourth and ninth floors, Interior Minister Ihor Klymenko said. Video showed black smoke billowing from corner units and burned out or damaged cars on a tree-lined street.

The dead included a 10vear-old girl and her mother, according to Zelenskyy. More than 350 people were involved in the rescue operation, he said in a Telegram post. The morning attack also

destroyed part of a four- annexed province. story university building.

The strike on Zelenskyy's hometown, which has been hit in the past, happened a day after the Ukrainian president warned that the fighting was drawing closer to Russian land. "Gradually, the war is returning to the territory of Russia —to its symbolic centers and military bases, and this is an inevitable, natural and absolutely fair process, Zelenskyy said Sunday in his nightly video address.

It was not clear whether the missile strikes were in retaliation for his comments. Meanwhile, a Ukrainian artillery strike on the partially occupied Donetsk province killed two people and wounded six others in the regional capital, according to Denis Pushilin, the Moscow-installed leader of the illegally

The Wall Street Journal first reported on the meeting in Saudi Arabia on Saturday, saying it would be held in Jeddah on August 5-6.

western suburbs, cars were swept away on Monday as relentless rain since the weekend transformed roads into rivers, killing at least two and trapping hundreds, despite an overnight evacuation of tens of thousands from their homes. Hundreds of roads

have become flooded in China's capital, with videos posted by state media showing half-submerged vehicles in Mentougou district pulled along by fastmoving torrents as the remnants of Typhoon Doksuri dumped record rainfall on the city of nearly 22 mil-

Two bodies were found in a river during an emergency patrol in Mentougou as rescuers pulled hundreds to safety in other parts of the city.

Besides Beijing, heavy rain continued to soak the neighbouring city of Tianjin as well as Hebei province in a region nearly the size of Britain in the wake of Doksuri, which

was downgraded to a tropicaldepression on the week-

Three of the five rivers that make up the Hai river basin rose to dangerous levels on Monday. Some houses were washed into the Yongding river, and nearly 55,000 people were evacuated from their homes in Baoding city, state media reported.

Doksuri was one of the strongest storms to hit China in years and caused widespread flooding over the weekend in the southem province of Fujian, driving hundreds of thousands of people from their homes. Average rainfall in

Beijing reached 176.9 mm (7 inches) between Saturday night and Monday afternoon, with the maximum recorded rainfall in at a weather station in Mentougou hitting 580.9 mm (23 inches), according to state media. Tens of thousands of people were evacuated from their homes in Beijing after heavy rainfall in the city following

Typhoon Doksuri.
