ISLAMABAD (INP): The National Electric Power Regulatory Authority (NEPRA) approved an in-crease of Rs2.75 in the electricity tariff applicable from April across the country under fuel price adjustment (FCA).

The power regulatory body forwarded its decision to the federal government for notifying the hike in the power tariff. After the notification, the new tariff would be in effect for the upcoming three months, imposing a significant burden on consumers amounting to Rs85.2 billion.

The decision was made with NEPRA's approval of the fiscal year 2023-24 second-quarter adjustment. **Distribution** Companies (Discos) requested a higher increase of Rs4.43 per unit; however, NEPRA decided to go with the Rs2.75 hike.

This increase, which will show up in the electricity bills for April, May, and June, is the result of several factors 'influencing' the operational costs of the power industry.



WASHINGTON (INP): US State Department spokesperson Matthew Miller on Wednesday maintained that assisting Pakistan in addressing its energy crisis re-mains a top priority for the United States.

During a routine news briefing in Washington on Wednesday, Miller when questioned about US pressure on Pakistan to halt its gas pipeline project with Iran, underscored America's commitment to aiding Pakistan's energy needs, noting that the US has provided substantial support, including 4,000 megawatts of energy through various projects.

These initiatives have significantly bolstered Pakistan's power generation capacity and are actively contributing to the provision of electricity to its citizens.

Miller also mentioned ongoing efforts in areas such as smart agriculture and energy. However, he refrained from commenting on the potential damages Iran may impose due to the pipeline project.

A day earlier, Matthew Miller told newsmen that the US does not support Pakistan's plan to build a pipeline to import gas from

Iran. He refused to comment on the nature of sanctions Pakistan could face for importing energy from Iran. However, he cautioned

Islamabad against going ahead with the plan. "But we always advise everyone case that doing business with Iran runs the risk of touching upon and coming in

and would advise everyone to consider that very carefully," said Miller, adding that "the assistant secretary made clear last week, we do not support this pipeline going forward."

Donald Lu, Assistant Secretary of State for South and Central Asia told the House Foreign Affairs committee last Wednesday in a hearing that importing gas from Iran would expose Pakistan to US sanctions.

Pakistan's outgoing caretaker government approved the construction of an 80-kilometer section of the pipeline in Febru-ary, largely to avoid pay-ing Iran \$18 billion in penalties for years of project delays

Miller's remarks came after Pakistani media reported Tuesday, Islamabad was planning to seek a US sanctions waiver.

Judiciary's SOS

Some clearly thought that senior judges would prove just as easily 'manageable' as our seasoned politicians usually are. They must have received a shock this Monday when almost the entire Islamabad High Court formally decided to take a stand and push back against what many of its judges describe as repeated interference and meddling in their court and the cases before them.

A day later, the public learnt that six of the IHC's eight sitting judges had forwarded a complaint to the chief justice of Pakistan to seek the Supreme Judicial Council's guidance on what judges ought to do when they are subjected to blackmail, harassment and coercion by "members of the executive, including operatives of intelligence agencies" The judges made it clear that they expected some action from the judiciary to reclaim its independence and improve vironment." their institution's deteriorating image in the eyes of the public.

The judges who co-signed the letter framed their demand for a judicial convention to look into the matter by referencing a recent judgement from the Supreme Court, in which it reinstated former IHC judge Shaukat Aziz Siddiqui's status as a duly retired judge. It may be recalled that retired justice Siddiqui had been unceremoniously ejected from the judiciary in October 2018 over a complaint he had made regard-

Climate change messing with how we measure time

Monitoring Desk PARIS: Struggle to wrap your head around daylight savings? Spare a thought for the world's timekeepers, who are trying to work out how climate change is affecting Earth's rotation ---and in turn, how we keep track of time.

In a strange twist, glo-bal warming could even help out timekeepers by delaying the need for history's first "negative leap second" by three years, a study published on Wednesday suggested.

Experts fear that introducing a negative leap second — a minute with only 59 seconds — into standard time could cause approached 0.9 of a sechavoc on computer systems across the world.

For most of history, time was measured by Earth's rotation. However in 1967, the world's time-which the world sets its keepers embraced atomic clocks

clocks - which use the frequency of atoms as their tick-tock — ushering in a more precise era of timekeeping. But sailors, who

still relied on the Sun and stars for navigation, and others wanted to retain the connection between Earth's rotation and time. There was a problem. Our planet is an unreliable clock, and had long been rotating slightly slower

than atomic time, meaning the two measurements were out of svnc. So a compromise was struck. Whenever the difference between the two measurements ond, a "leap second" was added to Coordinated Universal Time (UTC), the internation-

Twisted magnetic field observed around Milky Way's black hole **Monitoring Desk**

mers on Wednesday announced that they have detected a strong and organised magnetic field twisted in a spiral pattern around the Milky Way's supermassive black hole, had revealing previously unknown qualities of the immensely powerful object lurking at the center of our galaxy.

The structure of the magnetic field emanating from the edge of the black hole called Sagittarius A*, or Sgr A*, closely resembles one surrounding the only other black hole ever imaged, a larger one residing at the centre of a nearby galaxy called Messier 87, or M87, the researchers said This indicates that strong magnetic fields may be a feature common to black holes, they added.
