

No matter how painful, a larger, medium-term IMF bailout, with complementary financial support from 'friendly' countries, is imperative for Pakistan to address its balance-of-payments troubles.

However, the key to unlocking fresh IMF funds lies in convincing the lender that Pakistan is now ready to undertake real reforms. Seeking a bailout of \$6bn-\$8bn before the current fiscal year ends, Finance Muhammad Minister Aurangzeb is set to hold discussions with the Fund for new lending on the margins of the IMF and World Bank spring meetings in Washington, as well as muster the support of 'friendly' nations for its request.

Negotiations for the new loan will not be easy even though the Fund is, according to the minister, "very receptive" to Pakistan's request for a new programme. Indeed, it has expressed its willingness to help Islamabad navigate through its couraging news coming in crisis ever since Pakistani authorities broached the subject of a follow-up programme with starting Friday. 


