According to the directives issued by PDMA on Sunday, it was mentioned that there are risks of lightning during rains in

It was also pointed out that lightning generally takes place at open and high places. Therefore, general

public should adopt preventive measures to save them from lightning, it was advised.

It was further advised to the citizens to avoid from taking shelter and sitting under trees during the lightning. The PDMA also issued directives to the people not to move in the plane fields, coasts and other open places and not use mobile phone games, landline phone, computer and laptop in open.

Moreover, the people were also advised not to travel on motorcycle and bicycle, etc. during lightning.

"Navigating Pakistan's Population **Challenge:** Strategies for Sustainable Growth"

Pakistan is grappling with a significant challenge: a continuous rise in its population growth rate, as highlighted in the latest census report. Data from the 2017 census revealed a growth rate of 2.4 percent, which has since increased to 2.55 percent by 2023. This alarming trend emphasizes the urgent need for comprehensive strategies to combat the various factors contributing to overpopulation in the country. Numerous factors con-

tribute to Pakistan's overpopulation predicament, spanning socio-cultural and economic realms. Access to family planning services remains a significant obstacle, with a notable 17% unmet need for contraception despite a contraceptive prevalence rate (CPR) of 34%. The persistence of unplanned fertility rates at 12% underscores the gaps in reproductive health services. Societal pressures play a crucial role in driving the demand for children, evident in the ideal family size of 3.9 for women and 4.3 for men. Alarmingly, 30% of women discontinue contraceptive use due to the desire for more children, perpetuating the cycle of population growth. 



ISLAMABAD (INP): Implementing the orders of International Monetary Fund (IMF), the Federal Board of Revenue (FBR) has decided to block the SIM cards of nearly 2 million individuals involved in tax evasion.

Sources stated that FBR chairman has greenlighted the blocking of SIM cards of tax evaders dispatched instructions to relevant officials.

The FBR has identified 1.8 million tax evaders. Sources claimed that the FBR also has the authority to disconnect electricity connections, besides blocking SIM cards of non-filers.

the way for further research into the role of the gut microbiome neurodegenerative conditions, say experts.

Fecal transplants could have an effect on the motor symptoms of people with Parkinson's disease, a recent study suggests.

A small, single-center clinical trial carried out in Belgium found that people with Parkinson's disease who received a single dose of a fecal transplant from a healthy donor, had improved symptoms compared to those who received a placebo.

Results, published in eClinicalMedicine, suggested that the motor score for people who received a donor transplant had improved by 5.8 points after 12 months, compared with an improvement of 2.7 points in people who received a placebo transplant.

constipation. Mild gastrointestinal symptoms were a common negative side effect at the time of the transplant and were more frequently observed in people who received the donor transplant. 

Escalating tension between Iran-Israel

While Iran's use of hundreds of drones and missiles to directly target Israel overnight on Sunday in retaliation for an Israeli strike on the Iranian consulate in Damascus set some major political and military precedents, but it has escalated tension between Iran and Israel and so in the region and world aggravating the conflict.

It was the single largest drone attack ever carried out by any country, and it was the first time Iran directly attacked Israel after almost a half-century of being archenemies.

Here's a look at what political military and economic consider ations Tehran might have factored in while deciding on the attack that has amplified fears of a larger regional war and that could also af fect the direction of Israel's war on Gaza.

Over several months.

Israel has tried to provoke Hezbollah, seen as an Iranian proxy in Leba-non, in the north, but failed to draw it into a full-fledged confrontation. It has attacked not just south Lebanon and Beirut and hit Hezbollah targets, includbut it is beginning to realise

blatant acts of provocation failed to draw Hezbollah and Syria into the Middle East conflict because the 'axis' powers possibly saw through Israel's tactics and chose restraint, so the focus remained solely on Israel's brutality in Gaza, which was slowly but surely beginning to change Western attitudes





Canada sacks Indian staffers working at its diplomatic missions in India

Monitoring Desk ONDON: Ties between Canada and India have deteriorated further as the

former has dismissed dozens of Indian staffers from service who were working at its diplomatic missions in India over the Indian regime's plan to assassinate pro-Khalistani Sikhs on Relations between

Canada and India started deteriorating last year when tens of thousands of Canadian Sikhs voted for Khalistan Referendum in several Canadian cities on the call of Sikhs For Justice (SFJ), led by Gurpatwant Singh Pannun who is a dual Canadian and US national.

The relations hit rock bottom when Indian assassinated SFJ and Khalistan Referendum's Canada coordinator Hardeep Singh Nijjar at the Canada's biggest Gurdwara in June 2023

and also tried to kill Pannun in New York.

A spokesperson for the Canadian High Commission stated that the reduction in the number of Indian employees was required in light of the country's shrinking Canadian workforce. "I can confirm that the Government of Canada has implemented some staff reductions across our network of missions in

India," the official said. The spokesperson, however, said that the high

commission expressed its sincere gratitude for the resilience, dedication, and service of its local staff in India.

After the murder of top Khalistani Sikh leader Hardeep Singh Nijjar in British Colombia, Canada's Prime Minister Justin Trudeau alleged that India was behind Nijjar's assassination
