ISLAMABAD (APP): The Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT) Police on Thursday made notable progress in a troubling case involving abduction and sexual assault. The incident was first reported when a woman was found on Wednesday, abandoned with her hands and feet bound within the Aabpara police station limits.

According to a police spokesperson, the woman who initially identified herself as Farwa and asserted that she was a Belgian citizen who had arrived in Pakistan in January 2024, has now been confirmed as Farwa Kayani, Daughter of Sultan Farid Kayani age 44 years a resident of Rawalpindi. At least 27,622,389 VPN downloads were made in the country, an over 50% increase from 2022 when the number of downloads stood at 17,345,605 which is the clear indication of an alarming situation

Moreover, Pakistan is not alone in its efforts to regulate VPN usage. According to reports, China leads the world in blocking VPN access, with about 73% of all attempts to access VPN providers being blocked. Iran and several Gulf Arab countries follow closely behind. Russia, North Korea, Iraq, the UAE, and Turkey have also implemented strict measures to restrict VPN usage, imposing significant penal-ties for violating VPN restrictions. In other countries,

cyber threats. Nevertheless, in Pakistan, there is a tendency to oppose such regulations. Individuals do not raise objections when VPN usage is restricted in locations like KSA or UAE. In these countries, freedom of expression is not jeopardized as their governments prioritize security and stability. It is solely in Pakistan where there is a demand for the lib-

erty to make offensive remarks under the pretext of free speech. However, the rationale behind Pakistan's selective approach towards VPNs is the aim of keeping Pakistani internet users safe while also avoiding undue harm to the growth of IT sector. 

Israel, his office said. The two leaders discussed recent developments and the steps to be taken for a lasting ceasefire and peace in Gaza, Erdogan's office said in a post on X.

Erdogan con-demned Israel's war in Gaza, the statement said, accusing some Western countries of remaining silent and continuing to support Israel

Erdogan also told of genocide. Turkish Abbas that all countries, especially in the Muslim world, should step up efforts to ensure an immediate ceasefire in Gaza and the uninterrupted delivery of humanitarian aid to Palestinians.

Abbas is set to address an extraordinary session of Türkiye's parliament on Thursday. Israel's assault on Gaza started after the Palestinian Islamist militant group Hamas attacked Israel on Oct 7.

Türkiye has denounced the war and has halted all trade with Israel. It submitted a request to join South hamas, Africa's case at the International Court of Haniyeh, who was as-Justice accusing Israel

Turkey's invitation to Abbas came after Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu addressed the US Congress on Jul 25, which Ănkara has condemned

"We will show that Mr Abbas has the right to speak in our parliament just as Netanyahu has the right to speak in the US Congress," Erdogan told members of his ruling AK Party on Wednesday before meeting Abbas.

Erdogan, who has been a staunch supporter of Hamas, said Turkey had also planned to invite the political leader of Ismail sassinated in Tehran.

In a notification to Congress, the State Department said it had approved a sale of 50 F-15 fighter jets to Israel for \$18.82 billion. Israel will also buy nearly 33,000 tank car-tridges, up to 50,000 explo-

sive mortar cartridges and new military cargo vehicles. The F-15 aircraft,

which will begin to be delivered in 2029, will upgrade Israel's current fleet and include radar and secure communications equipment

'The United States is committed to the security of Israel, and it is vital to US national interests to assist Israel to develop and maintain a strong and ready self-defense capability," the State Department said in its notice on the F-15s, which

are made by Boeing. On the tank car-tridges, the United States said the sale "will improve Israel's capability to meet current and future enemy threats, strengthen its homeland defense and serve as a deterrent to regional threats.

Kolkata doctor case: **Protests escalate in** India over gruesome rape of doctor

Monitoring Desk MUMBAI: Thousands of women marched across several Indian cities overnight and Prime Minister Narendra Modi called for strict punishment for crimes against women, as outrage and protests against

the gruesome rape and murder of a doctor escalated. Holding candles and posters that said "reclaim the night", women held marches across cities, including the eastern Indian city of Kolkata, where the rape and murder of a trainee doctor last week has triggered protests by fellow medics, demanding better and safer working conditions. Many government hospitals in cities across India suspended all services except emergency departments earlier this week, as junior doctors sat outside in protest, demanding jus-

tice for the victim. The 31-year-old doctor was found dead on Fri-

day. Police said she had been raped and murdered and a police volunteer was subsequently arrested in connection with the crime.

"As a society, we have to think about the atrocities being committed against our mothers, daughters and sisters. There is outrage against this in the country. I can feel this outrage," Modi said in an address to the nation on its 78th Independence Day on Thursday. The rape has revived memories of a similar case in New Delhi in 2012, when a gang of men raped and severely injured a 23-year-old student in a moving Delhi bus, leading eventually to her death.

'This horrific incident has once again reminded us that women disproportionately bear the weight of ensuring their own safety," Bollywood actor Alia Bhatt said in a post on her Instagram page, which has more than 85 million followers.

FO tightens visa rules amid rise in political asylum claims by parliament staff

ISLAMABAD (INP): The visa purposes to the fami-Foreign Office has introduced stricter guidelines on the issuance of visa notes and note verbales for the Senate and National Assembly Secretariats after the growing trend of Parliament employees and officers seeking political asylum abroad.

Following the approval of Deputy Prime Minister Ishaq Dar, the Foreign Office immediately implemented these new guidelines. Foreign Secretary Cyrus Sajjad Qazi communicated the changes through an official letter addressed to the Secretaries of the Senate and National Assembly, outlining the revised procedures.

The letter specifies that the facility of issuing note verbales for private and official passport holdvisits to holders of diplomatic and official passports has been discontinued. Additionally, the issuance of from the Senate or National letters of introduction for Assembly Secretariat.

lies of officers from the National Assembly and Senate Secretariats has been banned.

For private passport holders accompanying members of Parliament on official and private visits, a new requirement mandates an affidavit to ensure that the visa-seeking individual will not seek asylum in the destination country. Furthermore, an undertaking must be provided, confirming that the Foreign Office's introduction letter will not be misused.

The guidelines also state that letters of introduction will no longer be issued to family members of officers from the National Assembly and Senate Secretariats. Diplomatic ers will now only receive note verbales for official visits after a formal request
